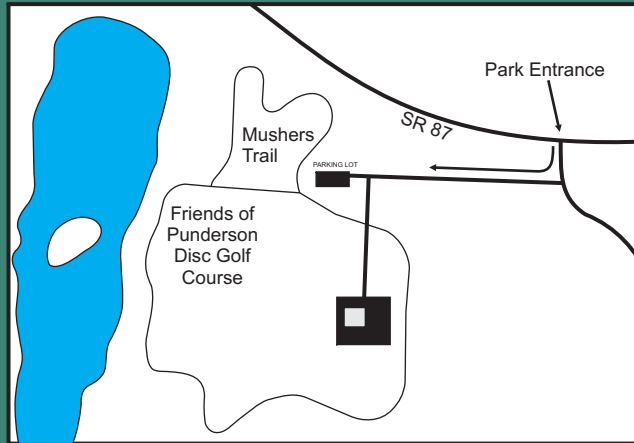

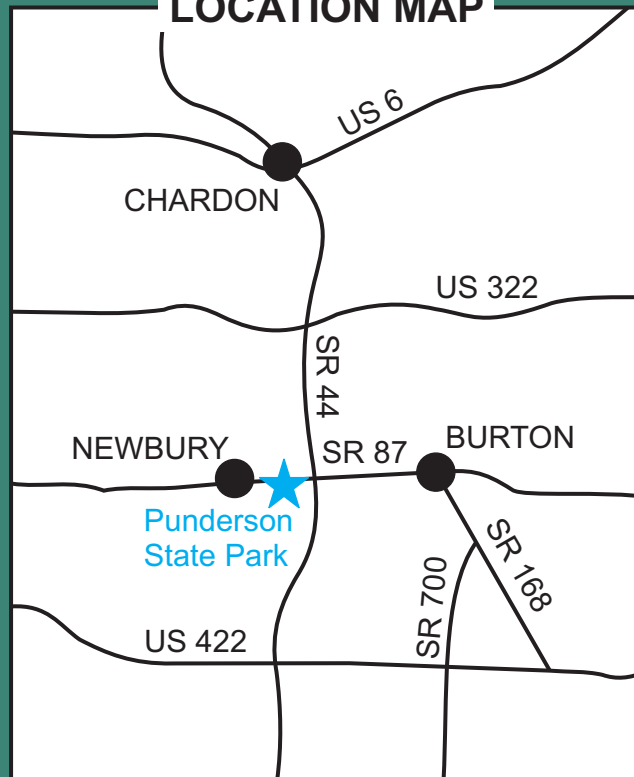

Where do I play?

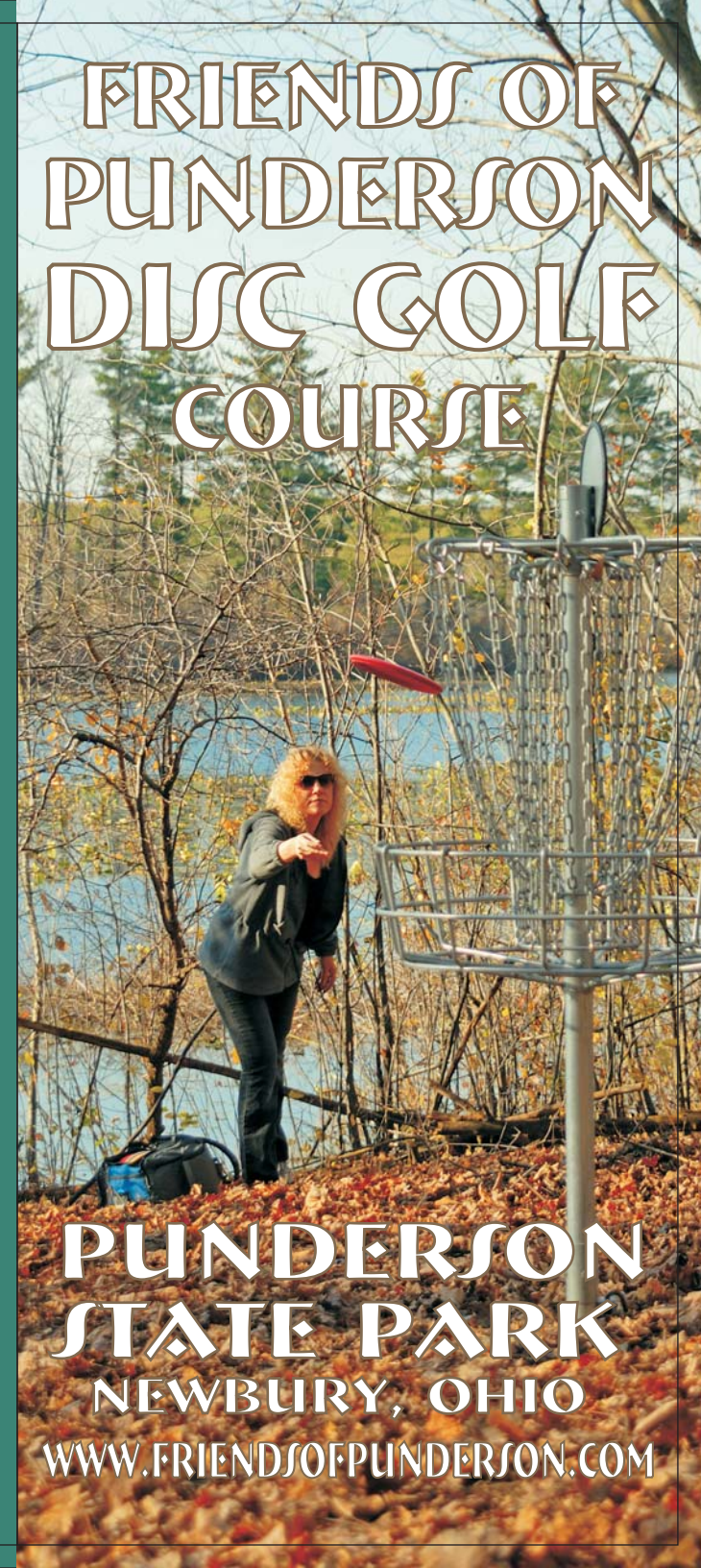
Enter the park off SR87. Take first right and go straight ahead to parking lot. Disc Golf Course is straight ahead 400 feet up Musher's Trail.

What is disc golf?



The sport of disc golf evolved as an offshoot of the many games spawned by the Frisbee® craze. The game started with people using Frisbees and aiming at random targets made up of trees, trash cans, light poles, pipes, and whatever else was handy.

Disc golf is similar to regular golf; however, instead of using golf clubs and balls aiming for a hole, Disc Golf players use discs and aim for a Disc Pole Hole, a pole extending up from the ground with chains and a basket where the disc lands. The object of the game is to complete each hole in the fewest number of throws, starting from a tee area and finishing at the Disc Pole Hole™. Generally, a course is 9 or 18 Disc Pole Holes long. Players start at hole one and complete the course in order, playing through to the last hole. The player with lowest total cumulative score wins.

GENERAL INFO

Disc Golf is played like ball golf using a flying disc. One point is counted each time the disc is thrown and when a penalty is incurred. The object is to complete the course with the fewest points possible. The winner has the lowest score.

TEE THROWS

Tee throws must be completed within or behind the designated tee area. Do not throw until the players in front of you are out of range. Play safely.

LIE

At the spot where the previous throw has landed, mark the lie with a mini disc marker or place your foot directly behind the lie in line with the basket.

THROWING ORDER

After teeing off, the player whose disc lies farthest from the hole always throws first. The player with the least amount of throws on the previous hole is the first to tee off on the next hole.

FAIRWAY THROWS

Fairway throws must be made with your foot closest to the hole on the lie of the previously thrown disc. Neither foot can be closer to the hole than the lie. A run-up and normal follow-through, after release is allowed.

DOG LEG

A hole with a fairway that turns left or right is called dog leg. Some dog legs have obstacles that the golfer is required to pass on a certain side. This passage is referred to as a mandatory, or mando. It will be clearly marked on the course and the tee sign for the hole. If the throw passes on the wrong side of the mando, the player is required to throw back and pass on the mandatory side.

COMPLETION OF HOLE

The hole is completed when the disc comes to rest in the chain or in the bottom of the basket. A disc coming to rest on top of the basket spokes does not count as a completed hole.

UNPLAYABLE LIE

Any disc that comes to rest above the ground is considered an unplayable lie. The disc must be thrown from the lie on the ground, directly beneath the unplayable lie, relocated to avoid damage to any vegetation.

OUT OF BOUNDS (O.B.)

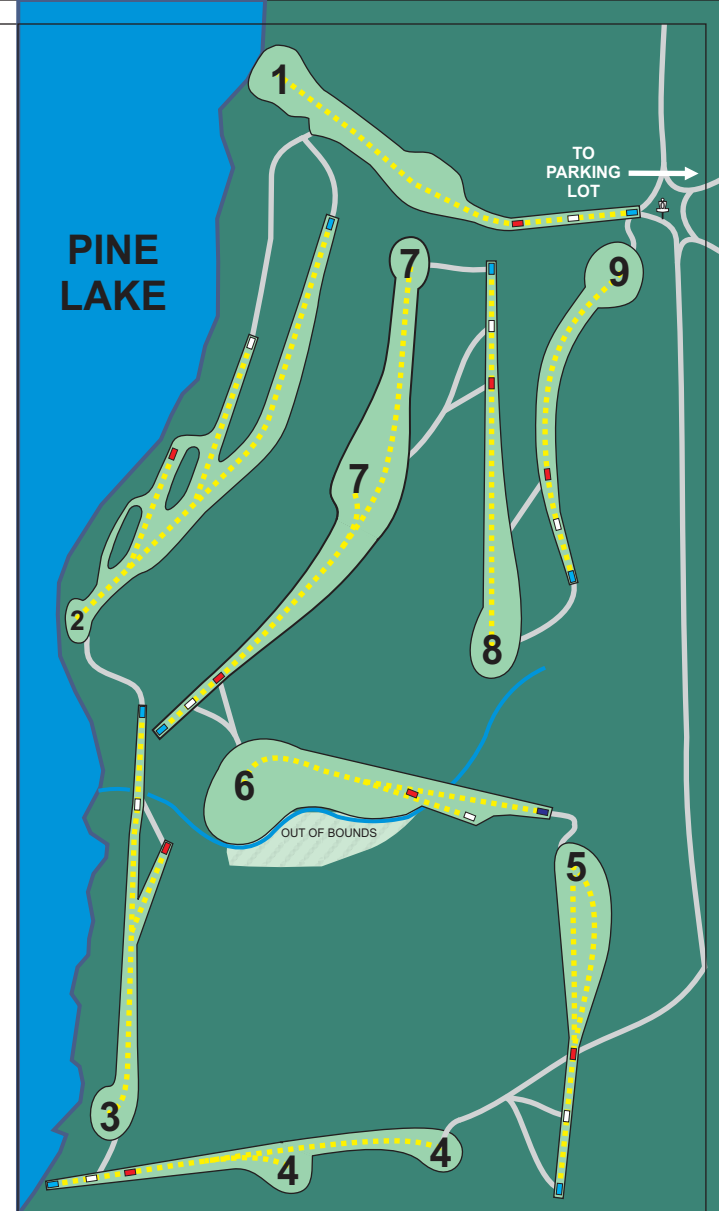
A disc is O.B. if there is visible distance between the disc and the marked O.B. line. A throw that lands out of bounds must be played from a point 3 feet in bounds from where the disc went out of bounds. A one throw penalty is incurred. Permanent water hazards, sidewalks, public and park roads are always out of bounds.

PENALTIES

Recreational players will not be penalized for rule infractions. Your friends will keep you honest.

COURSE COURTESY

Please pick up trash and help new players play by the rules. You are the one that makes it work, by your example. Disc Golf will change your life, and theirs too. Remember the most important rule; The one who has the most fun wins!
